Adopt a Catholic Student in Kenya

In Kenya, tuition is required for students attending secondary schools and private academies.

Families must pay a school fee of \$300 for primary and \$550 for secondary education. Each child must also have a school uniform.

School fees provide tuition, text books, exercise books, a uniform, and lunch.

Many families are large, and sacrifice almost everything to provide an education for their children.

The Adopt a Catholic Student in Kenya is operated by volunteers. 100% of a sponsor's donation is spent on a child's tuition.



Adopt a Catholic Student in Kenya Program

Currently, parishioners have adopted over 20 Primary & Secondary Students.



How does it work?

Immaculate Conception Parish, in Arlington, and St. John Vianney Mission, in Darrington, formed a Sister-Parish covenant with the Cathedral Parish of Christ the King in Bungoma, Kenya. An important part of that covenant is providing school fees for children in the Cathedral school and in high schools where parishioners attend.

When an individual expresses an interest in adopting a student and provides the annual school fee, they will be given the student's picture, a letter from the student, and the

student's address to facilitate communication with the student and his or her family.

The annual tuition is paid in advance, one year at a time. The minimum tuition commitment is one year.

Since the program started in December 2006, Immaculate Conception and St. John Vianney parishioners have already provided educations for over 20 primary and secondary students
