## **PASTOR'S CORNER: Feb. 11-12, 2012**

### ***Freedom of Conscience issues:***

My dear friends, Our Church and our faith is being severely tested these days. I ask you to pray and pay close attention to the information I have already made available to you about Same Sex Marriage and provisions of the National Health Care program. Archbishop Sartain and Bishop Elizondo have asked us to call these important areas to your attention. Essentially they both deal with religious freedom. Please consider writing to or e-mailing our state and national representatives. I'm sure there are some who will not agree with our Church's moral positions in these matters. I respect your freedom of conscience as well.

### ***Creating of Parish timeline:***

For a long time I have wanted to create a timeline of our parish's long history. We have already got a good beginning with a timeline Sue Hanowell and others created a number of years ago. Now in 20 year increments or so we want to graphically display the key events which have marked our history.
