PASTOR'S CORNER: FEB. 18-19 LENT IS HERE MAKE A GOOD PREPARATION FOR LENT:

Wednesday is the 1st day of Lent! I call your attention to all the info in today's bulletin which is meant to help you plan a spiritually meaningful Lent. Jesus' 40 days of fasting and prayer in the desert invites us to spend our Lent in prayer and fasting as well. Our daily Lenten scriptures provide great meditation opportunities all through Lent. Perhaps you could plan to attend daily Mass during Lent as we reflect daily on these great readings and are nourished by the Lord's Body and Blood. The Stations of the Cross are also a great opportunity for reflection. While I encourage you to attend the Friday Fish Fry and the celebration of the Stations of the Cross afterwards, I also urge you to stop by the church and pray the Stations of the Cross on your own. There will be various versions of the prayers in the vestibule.

PETE DOLAN MEMORIAL CHALICE: At our 9:00 Mass today we will bless a gold chalice in memory of Pete Dolan. Our Knights of Columbus 4th Degree Assembly donated the chalice in his memory. This chalice will be used especially at K of C celebrations. Pete was a 4th Degree Knight and is especially remembered for his key role in the Santa Claus parties for over 13 years. He lived his final years at Wrobliski Manor and was often seen motoring around in his wheelchair. The Pete Dolan College Scholarship honors his great love and work with our youth. He had a "heart of Gold".
